NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following slipway launching facilities situated on the River Wear will be permanently closed to public access with effect from the dates stated below:

Claxheugh Slipway, South Hylton, Sunderland (OS Grid ref NZ 363576):
Friday, 25th May, 2012. *This slipway will remain available for use by authorised boating, sailing and rowing club members.*

Fatfield Slipway, James Steel Park, Washington (OS Grid ref: NZ 317542):
Monday, 28th / Tuesday, 29th May, 2012.

The above implementation dates may be varied due to operational reasons.

The sole authorised slipway for public launching and recovery of small craft and vessels within the jurisdiction of the Port of Sunderland is situated at Potato Garth (OS Grid ref: NZ 407583), off Sand Point Road / Beacon Drive, Roker, Sunderland.
