NEW NAVIGATION BUOYS ESTABLISHED

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that starboard-hand lighted buoys have been established as aids to navigation, marking the northern extremity of the navigation channel and Swinging Basin within the River Wear, as follows:

SAND POINT BUOY

Position: 54° 54' 53.717N 001° 22' 04.555W
Conical, Green, Fl.G. 2.5 s., no topmark

POTATO GARTH BUOY

Position: 54° 54' 58.364N 001° 22' 00.712W
Conical, Green, Q.G., no topmark
