### ENTRY INTO ENCLOSED OR CONFINED SPACE

This Permit to Work must be completed before the commencement of any work in enclosed or confined spaces.

The Master is responsible for ensuring this form or a similar permit from the port is issued for all enclosed or confined space work. All boxes must be completed with details or a tick. Where a reference is not applicable N/A must be written. If an oxygen analyser is onboard the ship a reading must be entered on the form immediately before entry.
