### **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

#### **ENGLAND NORTH EAST COAST**

#### **DEPLOYMENT OF ADCPs, SUNDERLAND HARBOUR**

##### **Ref. No. 21 of 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that with effect from Sunday, 11th November, 2018, two “Acoustic Doppler Current Profilers” (ADCPs) will be deployed on the seabed within the Outer Harbour at Sunderland in the following positions:

**ADCP-01:** 54° 55' 10.4"N 01° 21' 30.9"W

**ADCP-02:** 54° 55' 15.3"N 01° 21' 13.8"W

Each will be fitted within a mooring frame, the height of which will not exceed one-metre above the sea bed. Their purpose is to measure current flow. They will be removed after approximately one month.

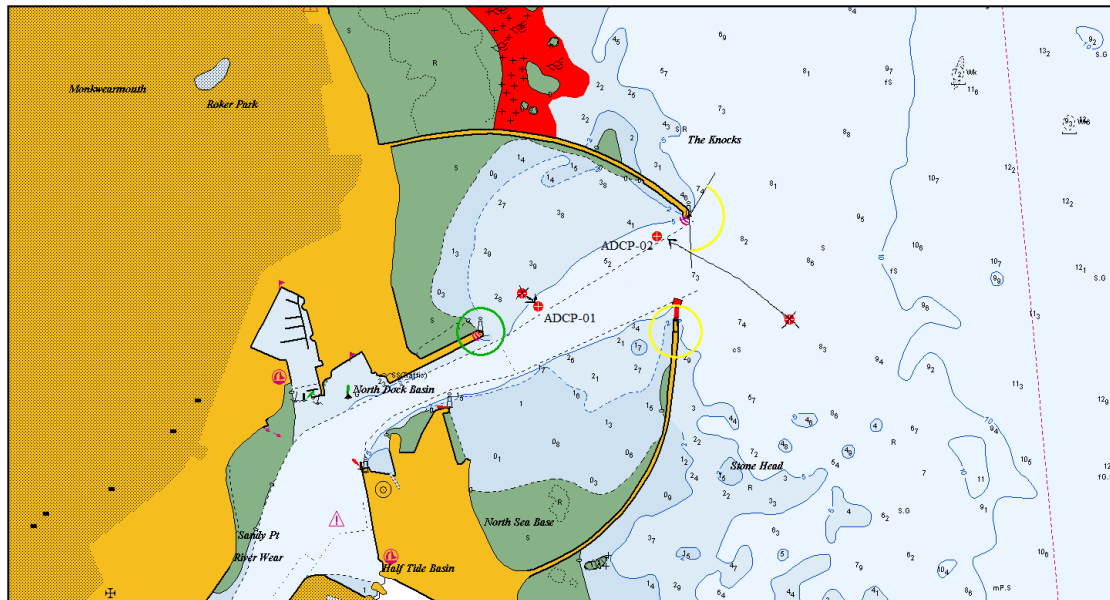
Both ADCPs will be positioned near the northern edge of the harbour navigation channel on a line between Old North Pier end and Roker Lighthouse. No surface marker buoys will be present. See plan appended at the end of this notice.

Masters of all vessels are warned that they must not drop anchor or set fishing pots in the vicinity of the ADCPs.

Mariners are again reminded of the prohibition of setting fishing pots within the Outer Harbour or its seaward approaches (Notice to Mariners 02 of 2015 refers).

A further notice to mariners will be issued once the ADCPs have been removed.
