NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Port of Sunderland Water Patrol Service commenced operations between the hours of 1100 and 1900 (subject to variation) from Monday, 29th March until Sunday, 26th September, 2021 (inclusive). During this period, patrols will be carried out during weekends, public holidays and school holiday weekdays.

The primary function of water patrols is to provide safety advice and guidance to operators of leisure vessels, particularly fast boats and personal watercraft; to initiate enforcement proceedings under the Port of Sunderland Byelaws, 1978, when appropriate; and to provide general assistance to all water users.

Patrols will be undertaken within the jurisdiction of the Port of Sunderland, primarily within the confines of the harbour and River Wear, using the Pioner Multi III vessel, call sign "**Sentinel**," which maintains radio watch on Marine VHF Channel 14.

From time to time, this vessel may be supplemented or substituted by the rigid hulled inflatable boat, "**Patrol**."

All vessel and other craft users are advised that Water Patrol Officers are authorised to act on behalf of the Harbour Master in the enforcement of port byelaws and that other port authority staff will continue to monitor waterborne activity outside the presence of dedicated patrols.
